Rosa Braber studied performance & acting at the Maastricht Theater Academy (Institute of Performing Arts) and graduated in 2012 as a Bachelor of Arts. During and after her studies she wrote and created solo performances and participated in collaborative performances and plays. Those were shown at festivals and different theaters in the Netherlands, Belgium, Germany and Austria.
